SCHOLARSHIP SPONSORED BY CPCU, SIP, IACNY**

1. An applicant must be either a child or grandchild:
  - a. of an employee of an active Agency that belongs to at least one of the sponsoring Organizations above.
  - b. of an employee of an active company that belongs to at least one of the sponsoring Organizations above.
  - c. of an active member of one of the Sponsoring Insurance Organizations above.  
(see bottom of this page for entry of necessary information to begin application)
2. An applicant must meet the following criteria, as outlined below:
  - a. A minimum grade point average of 80, B or 3.00 throughout high school and/or college. Attach official transcript(s).
  - b. Participate in extracurricular activities with particular consideration given to activities of a community service nature. Attach your list of activities.
  - c. Acceptable demonstration of written expression in the form of an essay of approximately 500 words.
3. Applications must be signed and postmarked by September,28, 2018. The winners will be notified by phone the week of October 13, 2018.
4. The scholarship will be paid directly to the student after they have provided proof of enrollment.
5. The student is responsible for notifying the school of the award.
6. A winner will become ineligible for the award if he/she fails to enroll in a school for the fall semester.
7. There are no restrictions on a student's choice of school.
8. The scholarship payment of up to \$2,000 will be made only once to any recipient.
